



English Writing

We will explore the book 'Leon and the Place Between'. Pupils will write in different styles including creating an advertisement, a diary entry, a letter and a character description. We will also plan, write and edit a narrative.

English Reading

"The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig — Eugene Trivizas"
"The Proudest Blue — Ibithaj Muhammad"
We will look at these two picture books across Autumn 1 to allow the pupils to understand the different aspects of reading comprehension. We will focus on skills such as summarising, clarifying, evaluating, inferring and predicting.

Mathematics

Place Value & Addition and Subtraction

In Place Value we will review and extend our learning of how to represent numbers up to 1,000, how to estimate a number on a number line, and how to compare and order numbers. In Addition and Subtraction, pupils will explore how to add and subtract numbers with no exchanges and with exchanges, as well as how to estimate answers.

Music

Reading Notation 1

Pupils will learn to read music notation with a focus on rhythm and tempo. Students will learn to read and understand basic rhythmic patterns. Building upon their prior experience with pulse and basic rhythm in Key Stage 1, this unit will help them to establish a firm grasp of rhythm and tempo.
