

Catch-Up Provision Report for St Barnabas and St Philip's CE Primary School

Academic Year 2020-2021



At St Barnabas and St Philip's this money will be used to:

- Purchase curriculum resources and materials that support pupils to get 'back on track'. These include Jigsaw –The Mindful Approach to PSHE, Read, Write Inc – a literacy programme for FS/KS1, Destination Reader –pedagogical reading approach for KS2 teachers, developed by Hackney Learning Trust.
- Fund additional support staff to develop the outcomes of pupils who have been identified as needing catch-up in their learning.

Aims

- To reach end-of-year challenging attainments targets in Reading/Phonics/Writing/Mathematics - see Appendix 1;
- To meet and support the mental health needs of pupils that have arisen as a result of the pandemic;
- To sustain and maintain outstanding behaviour throughout the school.

Catch-up at St Barnabas and St Philip's is for all pupils to:

- **Work through well-sequenced, purposeful learning schemes.** For example, schemes are being adapted to focus on missed objectives and consolidate the basics. In maths, we will utilise the White Rose scheme with a focus on sentence stems.
- **Focus on consolidation of basic skills.** The core skills which enable successful learning will require increased curriculum time across all year groups. These include: handwriting, spelling of high frequency words, basic sentence punctuation, times tables recall, basic addition and subtraction fact recall and reading skills relevant to age.
- **Benefit from additional lesson time on core first wave teaching.** Reading, writing and maths teaching will require increased teaching time in order to cover missed learning – particularly in the autumn and spring terms. We are keeping a broad and balanced curriculum- only French has been postponed until spring 2.
- **Focus on early reading and phonics.** This is always a focus in the school and will continue to be so in order to develop pupil's word reading and comprehension.
- **Assessment of learning and of basic skills to identify major gaps.** Teachers will work to identify gaps in learning and adapt teaching accordingly.
- **Invest in the development of mental health, wellbeing and social skills.** This will be at the core of all catch-up work as many pupils will have not been in a formal school setting for a number of months.

Catch-up at St Barnabas and St Philip's is for some pupils to:

- **Access additional support and focus on basic core skills.** Supported by additional staffing, utilising catch-up premium – dependent on need as identified through formative assessment.
- **Additional time to practise basic skills.** This again will be dependent on needs of pupils in order to re-establish good progress in the essentials (phonics and reading, expanding vocabulary skills, writing and mathematics). There will be flexibility in timetabling to allow this.

Catch-up at St Barnabas and St Philip's is NOT:

- Cramming missed learning;
- Pressuring children and families into rapid learning;
- Teachers time spent highlighting missed objectives;
- Teachers time spent ticking off assessment points and extra tracking.
