



English

In English, we will be exploring different texts through the RWI scheme and using them as inspiration for our writing. We will continue to have daily *speed sound* lessons to recap and consolidate the sounds that we have learnt in order to decode (read) and segment (spell).

Maths

This term in Maths, we will start by naming 2D and 3D shapes and using them to create patterns. We will then be learning to count, compare, order, add and subtract numbers to 20 and 50 as well as counting in 2s and 5s and measuring length, height, weight and volume.

Science

This half term, we will be learning about the seasons and changes that occur in different seasons. After half term, we will be learning about everyday materials, their properties and how they are used.

Religious Education

This half term in RE, we will be learning about Judaism and what it means to be Jewish. After half term, we will be learning about the story of Noah and the Easter story.

Art and DT

This half term in DT, we will be designing and making a cereal. The following half term in Art, we will be exploring colour.

With Miss Sato we will continue to understand pulse and beat in songs by;
