The school currently has no pupils with a physical disability and no staff with physical disabilities

Our access routes are not designed for wheel chair access.

Classrooms are all on split levels and some are small.

The school currently has no pupils with hearing difficulties.

Acoustics in the hall are not good because of the height of the ceilings.

The school has two members of staff with impaired vision.

The school is required to produce a disability equality and access plan for increasing disabled pupils' participation in the school curriculum etc.

Definition: A pupil has a disability if he or she has a has a disability which prevents or hinders him or her from making use of facilities of a kind generally provided for others of the same age in mainstream schools.
